### **GLORY BE TO THE TRIUNE GOD!**

"Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen." - Luke.24.5

### Dearly Beloved

Greetings to you all in the name of our risen Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

As we celebrate the glorious resurrection of our Lord, we are once again blessed to reflect deeply on the mystery of God's immense love revealed through the death and resurrection of His Son. Easter is not merely the culmination of the Passion narrative—it is the victorious proclamation of life conquering death, of hope dispelling despair, and of divine love triumphing over sin. It is the divine assurance that God's redeeming grace knows no bounds. In the light of the empty tomb, we are reminded of the eternal promise offered to all who believe: "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." — John 3:16

In the fullness of time, the eternal Son of God took on human flesh, fulfilling the Father's redemptive plan. Through His incarnation, Jesus Christ entered fully into the human condition, humbling Himself and becoming obedient even to death on a cross (Phil. 2:6–8). In doing so, He reversed Adam's disobedience and restored our relationship with God through His resurrection.

Through His resurrection, Christ triumphed over sin and death, opening the way for us to share in His divine life. We are no longer bound by fear, sin, or despair. As Scripture says, "Since we have confidence to enter the sanctuary by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh" (Heb. 10:19–20), we are called unto the very presence of God.

Christ's resurrection is the foundation of our faith. As St. Paul declares, "Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures... was buried... was raised on the third day... and appeared to many" (1 Cor. 15:3–5). The early Church witnessed to this truth with unwavering conviction, and we continue to proclaim it today: Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!

Our Lord rose from the dead in a way that went far beyond human understanding or expectation. Even His closest followers struggled to believe at first. Though the tomb had been sealed and guarded by the Jewish leaders, who feared the disciples might take His body, He still rose, defying every precaution. The women who came early that morning to anoint His body, moved by love and tradition, had no thought of finding the tomb empty; yet it was to them that the Risen Lord first revealed Himself. Meanwhile, the disciples, filled with sorrow and fear, had gathered behind closed doors, grieving and without hope. And it was in that very place that the Risen Lord came to them.

Each time the Risen Lord appeared to His disciples, He turned their disbelief into faith and filled them with courage to proclaim the gospel. None turned back. Many became bold witnesses even unto death. If we truly believe and confess, then we know there is hope for redemption in any circumstance, and victory from any failure. No matter how hopeless life may seem, He brings new life. For the One who conquered sin and death is able to transform even our deepes struggles into triumph.

Let this Easter be not merely a remembrance but a true participation. Let us renew ourselves, casting off all that clings to death: fear, sin, and despair, and walk in the light of the Resurrection. For just as Christ is risen, so too are we invited to rise each day into the likeness of God, and to grow continually in divine wisdom.

May the Risen Lord, who defeated the darkness of the grave, help us to sustain in His divine grace, and may His everlast ing presence fill our hearts with divine joy, peace, and love.

### The Holy Sanctuary (Madbaha)



The Holy of Holies is the most important and the most sacred place in our church building. The other parts are:

- ♦ Holy Place Place inside the rails/ Azhikakam
- Nave/ Hykala Main area where the congregation stands
- Portico/ Poomukham the porch area outside the main entrance

The Holy of Holies or the Sanctuary is the place where the altar of worship is erected.

The Holy of Holies and the altar have simililarity with the inner division of the Temple of Jerusalem.

The Holy altar is at the centre of the Holy of Holies or Sanctuary. All services in the church are centered on the Holy of Holies.

### Theological Significance of Holy Madbaha:

- The Holy Madbaha is depicted as equivalent to Golgotha.
- It is also compared to the Mount of Sinai where God descended down and visited His people.
- It is also compared to Paradise, where there is the tree of life and unending songs of the sacred congregation.
- Above all, it is held as heaven itself.


